Resolutions Adopted at the Milli Convention:

Identify the encroached and neglected wakf land and formulate appropriate scheme

The wakf properties in large scale in various parts of the country were acquired, neglected, encroached and trespassed upon without any rhyme or reason.No concerted or concrete steps were taken to restore the wakf land.The SJC expresses its great concern to the mute and evasive approach of the government in this matter. A tribunal has to be constituted to identify and locate confiscate and restore the trespassed wakf properties and a scheme has to be formulated to utilize the proceeds for the welfare and uplift of the beneficiaries of the society.

Implement Rangnatha Mishra Commission Recommendations

This National Milli Convention convened as part of Social Justice Conference calls attention of Central Government to implement as expeditiously as possible justice Rangnatha Misra Commission recommendations.

The Sachar Committe could submit a report with a treasure of comprehensive statistical data with inadequate representation in governmental and non-government organs justifying the Muslim demand for positive discrimination. But when we analyze the Sachar Report, the grievances of minorities on remedial action the pivotal point of reservation adequate representation in education and employment has been side lined or ignored.

The national commission for linguistic and religious minorities led by Justice Ranganatha Mishra submitted the report to the Central Government as early as on 21st may 2007. The report contains specific suggestion to effect adequate representation of minorities in employment and education. The recommendation of the Mishra Commission shall be immediately implemented by the central government in view of the existing social and educational backwardness of the religious and linguistic minorities.

Justice mishra commission segregated 15% of jobs in government services and seats in educational institution for minorities, out of which 10% exclusively, for the Muslim community. The commission reserves 8.4% out of existing OBC quota of 27% for minorities, of which 6% exclusively for Muslim OBC,s

The Milli Convention urge the government to initiate concerted endeavour to speed up the implementation of Ranganatha mishra commission report.

REBUILD BABARI MASJID AND PUNISH THE CULPRITS

The SJC of the popular front of India expresses extreme concern on the judgment of the 3 judges bench of Allahabad H.C partitioning Babari masjid precincts and the appurtenant land. The verdict negates the basic tenets of law, equity and good conscience. The title suit appeal now pending before the honorable Supreme Court shall be disposed of expeditiously with utmost care and caution.

The destruction of Babari masjid is the most heinous event in the history of independent india and the civil society witnessed the involvement of fascists leaders and cadres in day light. To restore people's faith in the rule of law the authority concerned shall resort to all legal recourse to see the leadership and its cadres are punished in the heinous crime booked against them. Also initiate bona fide endeavour to restore the Babari land to the Muslims.

GOPALGARH

As the Elections in UP and other states reaching near the communal forces became agile and active. In Rajasthan, with the connivance of police, these forces played a sinister game in Gopalgarh in which Muslims were killed and burnt and few are missing till now. The CBI investigation is on snails phase.

This Milli Convention demands that the investigation should go swiftly, murder case should be launched against the culprits, officials and the Home Minister. He should be ousted from the present Cabinet as Chief Minister done in the case of Banwari Devi issue.
